The rate of change of the position of an object.

$$S = D \div T$$

Measured in units of
m/s or km/h

TIME

A limited period or interval, as between two successive events.

$$T = D \div S$$

Measured in units of
Seconds (s)
or
Hours (h)

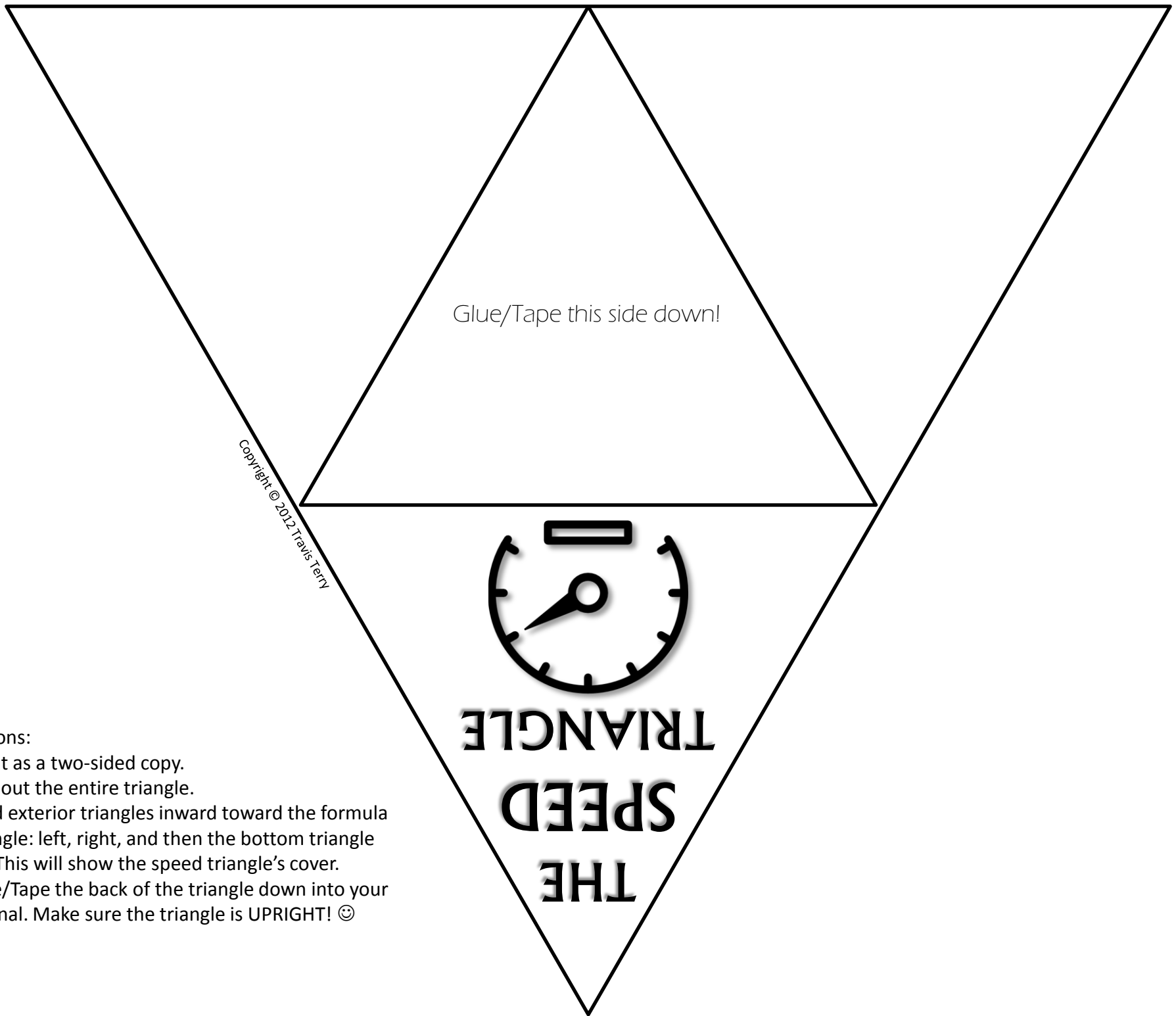
DISTANCE

The interval between two points of position.

$$D = T \times S$$

Measured in units of
Kilometers (km)
or
Meters (m)

Directions:

1. Print as a two-sided copy.
